TRINITY WESTERN UNIVERSITY is the only university in Canada to receive four consecutive A+ ratings for quality of education in *The Globe and Mail* Canadian University Report, and one of the top three Canadian universities for career preparation according to this year's results. In the most recent survey, TWU again earned top marks in such categories as teaching, most satisfied students, and student/faculty interaction. The ratings are the result of extensive research by *The Globe and Mail*, involving more over 38,000 students at 53 of Canada's universities.

Along with *The Globe and Mail* Canadian University Report, *Maclean's* ranked TWU as the best in Canada for "Enriching Educational Experience," based on their compilation of the National Survey of Student Engagement. TWU ranked as one of the top five Canadian schools in five of the six survey categories.
