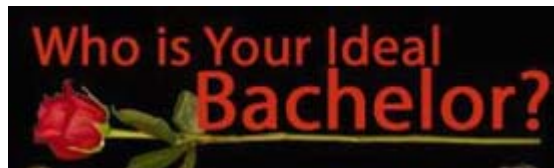

The Global Leaders Centre (GLC) will be coming to Vancouver to recruit for the next Global Vision Junior Team Canada to represent British Columbia on its JTC Trade and Development Missions to the Americas and Asia, as well as the APEC and G8 summits.

At the GLC, delegates from the ages of 15-30, comprised of high school, undergraduate, and graduate students, as well as young business professionals, will find out how they can gain international business and development experience as well as network with top business and government leaders in our region. Many graduates of the program have gone on to become Trade Commissioners, Ambassadors, and successful business owners.

The two day event will include leadership seminars, team building activities, a networking breakfast, and discussion panels featuring special guest speakers Brian Bonney from the Canadian Federation of Independent Businesses and the Honourable Iain Black, Minister of Small Business, Technology, and Economic Development.

Delegates will also have the opportunity to engage with Junior Team Canada alumni, diplomatic representatives from Vancouver consulates, and members of Canadian export development agencies such as the *Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA)*, *Export Development Canada (EDC)* the *Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT)*, and the *Department of Western Economic Diversification (WD)*.

- The G8/G20 National Youth Forum (Ottawa, May 2010)
- The G8/G20 Summits (Huntsville and Toronto, June 23-28 2010)
- The JTC Trade and Development Mission (China, August 2010)
- The APEC Summit (Tokyo November 2010)

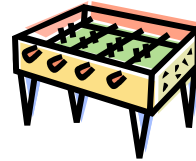
