

# Canadian Pacific Aboriginal Leadership Award

The **Canadian Pacific Aboriginal Leadership Award** has recently been expanded, and is now available to support more Aboriginal students who wish to pursue leadership training—and share their knowledge and experience within their communities.

Initiated by Canadian Pacific to support Aboriginal communities, the **Canadian Pacific Aboriginal Leadership Award** was initiated to enhance leadership skills within the Aboriginal community. The scholarship, awarded to Aboriginal students enrolled in the MA Leadership or MA Educational Leadership programs at Trinity Western University, was established in the 2009-10 academic year.

This Canadian Pacific investment will assist in the development of promising future Aboriginal leaders who will help sustain their communities.

The MA Leadership program is currently accepting applications for the summer 2011 cohort. Apply by May 15th, and you could be eligible for for a scholarship of up to \$6500 per academic year.\*



## Eligibility Criteria



*\*Note: Scholarship funding is not applicable to the first Summer semester, unless deemed appropriate by the Program Director; each case will be considered on merit.*

1. Applicant must be an aboriginal learner
2. Applicant must qualify for TWU's Master of Arts in Leadership degree program
3. Applicant must demonstrate financial need
4. Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential
5. Applicant's GPA must be 3.0 or higher
6. All scholarship funding is based on uninterrupted study and satisfactory academic progress in all courses.
7. Applicant must disclose all aspects of financial support they are receiving (employers, third party organizations, etc.); failure to do so may result in withdrawal of scholarship funding.
