The successful candidate will have fully embraced the beliefs and lifestyle of an evangelical Christian, will be supportive of the University's mission and will be able to contribute positively to the advancement of this evangelical Christian community.

HEAD COACH - MEN'S SOCCER

The major responsibilities for this full time CIS coaching position are, under the format of the Complete Champion Approach™, to:

- Recruit and develop student athletes with high (CIS level) athletic skills and moral character;
- Develop a perennial national contender;
- Create a following of loyal supporters and partners to help financially;
- Provide coaching leadership in the ongoing development and improvement of the student athletes and overall program.

These responsibilities will be fulfilled through coordination, planning, evaluation, and implementation of programs. Additional responsibilities include the legal expectation to ensure that proper training techniques such as teaching motor and life skills through regular practice, reinforcement and feedback are used. Additionally, responsible to see that safe facilities and equipment are provided, current methods of physiological injury prevention are used, and that all coaching staff is properly certified. Another important responsibility is to implement and follow through on fund and friend-raising initiatives. Must be a team-player in working respectfully and cooperatively with the Director of Athletics and Spartan Athletics administrators in; game and practice scheduling, home game coordination, facility issues, travel planning, budgeting, purchasing of specialized equipment and apparel, and completing necessary administrative requirements. The coach will be expected to develop recruiting networks through contact with secondary school athletes, coaches, clubs, teachers, parents and Spartan U - summer camp programs, academies, etc., as well as to promote the team through the local media and school districts.

Minimum requirements include a Bachelor's degree, NCCP Level III coaching certification, class IV BC Drivers License or equivalent, and several years of coaching experience at the university or equivalent level. Superior interpersonal, teamwork, organizational, leadership, coaching, and technical skills are also required. A pleasant personality together with a positive, friendly attitude in the midst of a busy and challenging atmosphere is essential.

In the first instance this position is offered to Canadian Citizen's or those with Permanent Resident status who will receive preference. The position will remain open until a suitable candidate is found however; candidates who apply by April 1 will be given preference.
