- Admission to the Honours program in Art + Design is by portfolio application to the department chair. Prospective candidates apply at the end of their second year; admission is also possible in third or fourth year. Alongside a strong portfolio, a grade point average of 3.0 is required for admission.
- A total of 134 s.h. of credit, including a minimum of 54 s.h. of upper-level credit is required to complete this degree. A minimum of 36 s.h. of upper-level credit is required in the major. Students must have a minimum overall (cumulative) GPA of 3.0 in all Art + Design courses, as well as an overall (cumulative) GPA of 2.7 to graduate.
- You must complete an <u>Application for Graduation</u> via the Student Portal and <u>submit a copy of your filled in program checklist(s)</u> (i.e. this document) to
