

Reference Questions

1. Your position/title; how long you have known the applicant and the context/relationship in which you have known him or her.
2. Academic and /or professional achievements—as demonstrated by grades received, rank in class (if known), positions held, and exceptional achievements within the workplace.
3. Academic potential—quality of analytical skills; ability to think critically, ability to apply skills and knowledge, judgment, originality, initiative, determination and ability to complete projects within an appropriate period of time, research contributions.

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4. Communication skills—as demonstrated by an ability to read, write and speak clearly in English; ability to work well with others, community involvement and other relevant extra-curricular activities.

5. Assess how you would see this individual as a professional in counselling psychology whose personal interactions would include empathy and insight into the needs of others.

6. Does their overall quality of character include integrity, reliability, and honesty in relationships with others?

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7. Please indicate if you highly recommend, recommend, recommend with reservations, or do not recommend the applicant to Trinity Western University's Counselling Psychology program.

8. Feel free to include any additional comments relating to their anticipated performance in Counselling Psychology and capacity to pursue graduate studies.
