

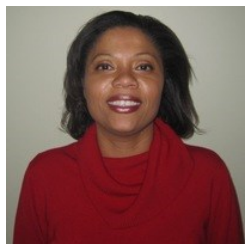
Nursing Networking Cafe

Reframing Trauma-Informed Mental Health Care

The Protective Function of Spirituality



Joan Samuels-Dennis (RN, PhD) has expertise in mental health promotion and trauma-informed care, and has held academic posts at York University and Humber College. She is currently the CEO and Founder of Trinity Centre for Health and Spiritual Innovation which provides evidence-supported, spiritually-informed mental health promotion programs to vulnerable groups.

Dr. Samuels-Dennis will present findings from a series of analyses that examine the protective role of spirituality particularly among vulnerable groups previously exposed to childhood and adulthood experiences of violence. Her presentation aims to reinforce the need to link spiritually-informed practice protocols with trauma-informed practice protocols in order to ensure the best mental health outcomes for our more vulnerable clients. Interactive discussions and a forgiveness-based activity will be used to explore the roles of chaplains/spiritual care providers and members of the health care team in promoting the mental health of Canadians.

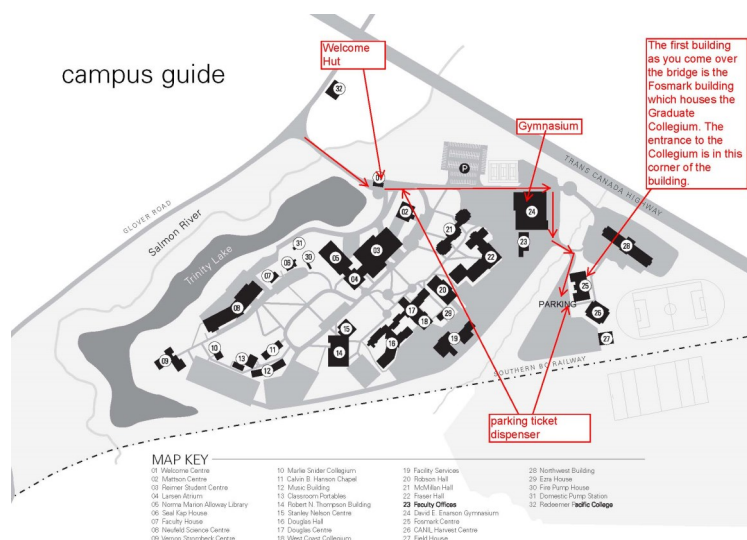
