- A minimum of 35 s.h. of credit is required for graduation. A minimum overall (cumulative) GPA of 3.00 is required for graduation.
- In cases where a student has accumulated 2,000 or more hours of teaching experience from a TESL Canada recognized institution, students have the option to apply to waive LING 640 (internship) in favour of taking a Directed Study Course (LING 800)
- In order to be eligible for graduation you must complete an Application for Graduation via the Student Portal. This is due by July 15 for participation in the fall ceremony and by January 15 for participation in the spring ceremony (there is no fee to apply for graduation). Once your application has been received, a degree audit will be completed for you. This audit will confirm which requirements are still outstanding in order for you to complete your degree.
