## Information for Presenters

Welcome to TWU's 2021 Research and Creativity Symposium! We hope that this event will be an exciting experience for everyone.

The symposium will consist of three, simultaneously live, virtual presentation rooms, each hosted by a moderator. Audience members will be free to move between the presentation rooms to attend selected presentations.

Throughout the day, two 15-minute breaks and a 45-minute lunch will be included.

### PREPARING

1. Prepare a research and/or creative presentation within your division's time limit.
2. Aim for one slide per minute, understanding this estimate may be discipline specific.
3. Use a minimum text font size of 20 in your slides. This will help you determine the amount of text to use.
4. Slides may contain animations, but video is not recommended.
5. Practice!

### PRESENTING

1. The moderator will introduce each presenter and read the title of their presentation.
2. While the moderator is introducing you, set up your PowerPoint by sharing your screen.
3. Presentations are organized by division and groupings.
4. Presentations are time sensitive:
  - a. Faculty: 20 min presentations
  - b. Graduate students: 15 min presentations
  - c. Undergraduate students: 10 min presentations
5. Questions at the end of each grouping, followed by a break.
