TEACHING EXPERIENCE

2016 - Current SAMC Art + Design | Trinity Western University

Fundamentals of Digital Design: This course offers a practical study of graphic design essentials specifically related to the elements of graphic style (image, type, and colour), conceptual ideation, and the visualization of ideas. Emphasis is given to investigating digital production practices, developing a visual communication vocabulary, and sharpening creative, analytical, and perceptual skills.

Symbol + Typography Design: An exploration of integrated conceptual thinking and formal experimentation with type and related symbol systems in graphic communications. Emphasis is placed on type as image, principles of typesetting, hierarchy, and structure. The complex interaction of type in relation to other graphic elements in multiple design contexts and formats is considered.

Format + Layout Design: An exploration of integrated conceptual thinking and formal experimentation with the structural and organizing systems at work in graphic communications. Emphasis is given to the development of unified graphic systems spanning multiple design contexts and formats.

Imaging + Illustration Design: An exploration of the conception, production, and analysis of imagery in graphic communication design, including photos, illustrations, and graphic marks. Imagery-based problems are investigated in multiple design contexts and formats. Specialized rendering techniques, digital studio practices and iconographic style development are considered.

Interaction Design: Introduces students to the design of interactive digital experiences with a focus on website design, User Experience (UX) design, and User Interface (UI) design. Students will learn the core concepts and principles of interaction design by working through technical and design projects using industry standard design software. Students leave this course with the ability to build websites and design digital experiences that follow current interaction design standards and methodologies.

Professional Practices: An overview of professional practices in art and design, with a focus on developing the practical skills and materials necessary for sustainable and healthy art and design careers. Students will engage in professional writing, portfolio development, networking, and career planning.

2013-2016 Instructor of Record | Southern Illinois University Carbondale

Introduction to Drawing I: Teaching basic observation drawing techniques to beginning students. The course focuses on the topics of line, composition, perspective, value, texture, proportion, measuring techniques, interior, landscape, and expressive mark making. Students assessed through consistent in-class and homework assignments as well as weekly group critiques.

Introduction to Drawing II: Building on and reinforcing the concepts of Drawing I, with the introduction of new materials and techniques. The focus is on a review of basic observation methods, perspective and spatial relationships, varying compositional structures, wet media including ink wash, color, and mark-making. Students assessed through consistent in-class and homework assignments as well as weekly group critiques.

2D Foundations: An exploration of fundamental art and design concepts with a hands-on approach to the creative and critical use of materials and techniques in a two-dimensional format. Individual and group projects covered in a wide range of topics and skills, including introductory color theory, mark making, relief printmaking, digital design, and stop-motion animation.

Introduction to Visual Culture: Developing visual and artistic literacy skills for engaging contemporary visual culture. Topics such as contemporary art, advertising, moving image, built environment, and virtual environment analyzed with an emphasis on semiotic techniques and analysis. Topics discussed in lectures are reinforced through weekly discussion sections.

Introduction to Web Design (Computer Graphics): Teaching contemporary web design and front-end coding techniques to a wide range of students with little or no prior web design knowledge. Toward the end of the course, students use Adobe Dreamweaver to design and custom-build a portfolio website to showcase their work using HTML5 and CSS3. Emphasis is placed on code literacy, creative problem solving techniques, visual hierarchy, UI/UX techniques, and Search Engine Optimization.

Introduction to Digital Art & Design: An introduction to the foundations of digital art and design for majors and non-majors. With a focus on using the Adobe Creative Suite on Apple computers, students gain proficiency and skills in digital illustration, digital imaging, image manipulation, layout, and digital output. Refinement and development of the design process is emphasized as well as technical proficiency and practical application. Primary programs utilized: Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign.
