- **NOTE:** A total of 31 s.h. of credit is required for graduation. All courses must be completed with a minimum overall GPA of 3.00. Students who do not maintain a B average in core courses may be asked to withdraw from the program.
- **NOTE:** Students must meet all graduation requirements within five years of beginning course work.
- **NOTE:** In order to be eligible for graduation you must complete an Application for Graduation via the Student Portal. This is due by July 15 for participation in the fall ceremony and by December 31 for participation in the spring ceremony (there is no fee to apply for graduation). Once your application has been received, a degree audit will be completed for you. This audit will confirm which requirements are still outstanding in order for you to complete your degree.
