- NOTE: In order to be eligible for graduation you must complete an Application for Graduation via the Student Portal and submit a completed checklist to the Office of the Registrar by April 30 of the year prior to your completion (there is no fee to apply for graduation). **Performance:** MUSI 331, 333 or 336; MUSI 370; MUSI 420, 450, or 460; MUSI 470; MUSA 4xx (1-hour lessons for 2 sem.)

**Music Education:** Choose three of MUSI 371, 372, 373, 374; MUSI 405; and MUSI 430.

**Church Music:** MUSI 401; MUSI 402; and a minimum 5 s.h. from: MUSI 320, 340, 403, 405.
