year; admission is also possible in third or fourth year. Alongside a strong portfolio, a grade point average of 3.0 is required for admission.

NOTE: A total of 134 s.h. of credit, including a minimum of 54 s.h. of upper-level credit is required for graduation. A minimum of 36 s.h. of upper-level credit is required in the major. A minimum GPA of 3.0 in all Art + Design courses as well as an overall (cumulative) GPA of 2.7 is required for graduation.

NOTE: Admission to the Honours program in Art + Design is by portfolio application to the department chair. Prospective candidates apply at the end of their second year; admission is also possible in third or fourth year. Alongside a strong portfolio, a grade point average of 3.0 is required for admission.

NOTE: In order to be eligible for graduation you must complete an Application for Graduation via the Student Portal and submit a completed checklist to the Office of the Registrar by April 30 of the year prior to your completion (there is no fee to apply for graduation). Once your complete application has been received, a degree audit will be completed for you. This audit will confirm which courses are still outstanding in order for you to complete your degree.
