- BBAH students must achieve an overall 3.3 GPA in all Business and Economics courses as well as for IDIS 410 (or POLS/IDIS 493 if attending the LLC).
- A total of 134 s.h. of credit, including a minimum of 54 s.h. of upper-level credit (48 s.h. in the major) is required to complete this degree. Students must have a minimum overall (cumulative) GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
