Purpose:

The objectives of this policy are:

- To establish a clear and transparent process for managing compliance with application eligibility qualifications, as defined by external granting agencies.
- To ensure compliance with external granting agency policies and procedures.

Scope of this Policy:

Faculty of Graduate Studies students from both the School of Graduate Studies (TWU) and the Graduate School of Theological Studies (ACTS).

Policy Statement:

Students who have applied for an external scholarship have the right to request an appeal of an initial screening of eligibility. A student who is unsatisfied with decision of an initial screening of eligibility of their award application may request further consideration first with the Graduate Studies Coordinator, and then, if necessary, may file an appeal with the Office of Research & Graduate Studies, and finally with the Provost.

Award decisions made by a TWU selection committee will not qualify for appeal.

Definitions:

External agencies: External organizations, both government and non-government, that facilitate awards competitions.

Initial screening: A process in which an application is reviewed for the purpose of determining eligibility.

TWU selection committee: A selection committee is composed of three or more eligible faculty members who are nominated by the Office of Research and Graduate Studies to fairly adjudicate awards competitions. Selection committee members have no conflict of interest with the student applicants and agree to confidentiality.
