If a student does not complete both CPSY 502 and 517 at a B grade or higher, they must switch to Non-Thesis track and take CPSY 504 plus another elective to fulfil checklist requirements. - A total of 63 s.h. are required to complete this degree. Students must have a minimum overall (cumulative) GPA of 3.0, and only courses with a B grade or higher will be counted towards graduation.
