



## Policy Title: Graduation Awards Qualification

### Purpose:

The objective of this policy is to define which students are eligible for scholastic awards at each graduation ceremony.

### Scope of this Policy:

Undergraduate and Graduate Studies

### Policy Statement:

In order for graduating students to qualifying for scholastic awards (including the Governor General's Gold and Silver medals):

- an associate of arts student must have completed at least 30 graded credit hours at Trinity Western University
- a bachelor's degree student must have completed a minimum of 60 graded credit hours at Trinity Western University
- Graduate students must have completed at least 50% of their program credit hours at Trinity Western University

### Definitions:

**Scholastic awards** include awards such as Governor General Silver Medal and Gold Medal, and Class Valedictorian.

**Undergraduate students** include all students in associate of arts and bachelor programs.

**Graduate students** include all students in master's and doctoral programs.
