Purpose:

The objective of this policy is to define which students are eligible for scholastic awards at each graduation ceremony.

Scope of this Policy:

Undergraduate and Graduate Studies

Policy Statement:

In order for graduating students to qualify for scholastic awards (including the Governor General's Gold and Silver medals):

- an associate of arts student must have completed at least 30 graded credit hours at Trinity Western University
- a bachelor's degree student must have completed a minimum of 60 graded credit hours at Trinity Western University
- Graduate students must have completed at least 50% of their program credit hours at Trinity Western University

Definitions:

Scholastic awards include awards such as Governor General Silver Medal and Gold Medal, and Class Valedictorian.

Undergraduate students include all students in associate of arts and bachelor programs.

Graduate students include all students in master's and doctoral programs.
