Rank the following positions in order of your preference:

First year students are eligible to apply for:

Projects & Communications Assistantship (PCA): Duties include event/project coordination (workshops, seminars, open house); admissions and web assistance; oversight of Wong Research Centre (bulletin boards, library & a/v resources); and general office duties (filing, shredding, data entry, projects as assigned). Strong computer skills desirable; flexible working hours.

Second year students are eligible to apply for:

Research Assistantship (RA): RAs will assist professor with research and publications. Please indicate your professor(s) of choice if applicable: _____

Teaching Assistantship (TA): Many courses require the assistance of a TA. These will be determined by the Program Committee prior to the start of the course. Please indicate your area of interest if applicable:

Testing Library Assistantship: Maintain inventory of testing materials & coordinate ordering of tests. Give students appropriate access to materials as well as ensuring the materials are returned. (This position may be combined with the TA position for CPSY 522-Basic Principles of Assessment.)

<u>Note:</u> First year student rate of pay is \$14.85 for not more than 10 hours per week. Second year student rate of pay is \$15.28 for not more than 10 hours per week.
