

TRINITY WESTERN UNIVERSITY ENGLISH HONOURS PROGRAM

I. Significance

1. An Honours program allows students in any discipline to specialize to a greater degree than is otherwise possible.
2. An English Honours program is the usual and preferred academic route for students contemplating graduate studies in English. (This does not preclude a dynamic interdisciplinary approach.)

II. Requirements (See also the Honours checklist)

1. For admission to all Honours programs at Trinity Western University, a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 at the time of application is required.
2. A minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 in all English courses and a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.7 must be maintained for graduation.
3. Students will be required to complete a minimum 134 semester hours of university-level studies (as opposed to the 122 semester hours required of regular students). This works out to an average of 16.75 semester hours per semester for a four year program.
4. Sixty semester hours in English courses are required, of which at least 36 semester hours must be upper level work, including ENGL 490 and 495 (Literary Theory I and II). Three hours of this will be an "Honours Essay" completed in the final semester of the program.
5. At least one half, i.e. 18, of the 36 semester hours of upper level English courses must be taken at Trinity Western University.

III. Application Procedure



1. Applications for the Honours English program should be made by November 30th or March 31st of the semester preceding the semester into which admission is sought.
2. Candidates for the Honours English program will normally apply for admission at the end of the second year of university studies (at TWU or elsewhere), but admission will also be possible during the first or second semester of a student's third year.
3. Application forms are available from the English Department or from Enrolment Services.
4. Applications should be submitted to the chair of the English Department.
5. Students interested in the Honours English program are invited to seek further information from any member of the department.
