


TRAVEL STUDY TO

Travel to the European destinations of Vienna, Muenchen, Dachau, Schwangau, Zurich, and London to learn about the history and setting of Freudian, Jungian, Adlerian, and Frankl's psychological theories.





#### **ACTIVITIES AND HIGHLIGHTS**

- 1. Tour historical sites and the Alps, and discover psychology's origins and evolution.
- 2. Visit museums, Jewish quarters, psychological institutes, Nazi concentration camps, castles, and art galleries—and learn from disciples and relatives of the European psychologists.
- 3. Discover how anti-Semitic issues effected their theories and the European perspective on psychology.

#### **COURSES**

## **PSYC 390 TR** EUROPEAN PSYCHOLOGISTS

This course explores the zeitgeist and environments of Freud, Adler, Frankl, and Jung to discover how the intellectual, political, social, economic, and religious climate of their time influenced their theories. Anti-Semitic influences will also be examined.

PREREQUISITES: PSYC 301 or permission of instructor.

# PSYC 408 TR HISTORY AND SYSTEMS OF PSYCHOLOGY

Historical roots of modern psychology. Major systems of thought within the discipline in the context of a Christian view on humans and the world. PREREQUISITES: PSYC 105, 106; plus 18 additional sem. hrs. of Psychology.
