

## **Policy Title: Graduation Requirements**

### **Purpose:**

The objectives of this policy are:

- To identify the online Academic Calendar/program checklists as the official source for graduation requirements.
- To provide clarity to students about which graduation requirements are applicable and available to them.
- To limit the responsibility of Trinity Western University to offer courses and programs to the current Academic Calendar/program checklist.

**Scope of this Policy:** All TWU and ACTS students.

**Policy Statement:** The official source of information regarding graduation requirements is the online Academic Calendar, including the embedded program checklists. Students may choose to follow the programs and requirements of the Academic Calendar/program checklist of the year in which they enroll or the Academic Calendar/program checklist of a subsequent year in which they are enrolled. Students may not mix requirements from multiple Academic Calendars/program checklists, nor may they choose to follow the requirements of an Academic Calendar/program checklist for any years prior to the year in which they enroll.

Undergraduate students who do not enroll for one or more years at TWU must re-enroll under the requirements of the most recent Academic Calendar/program checklist.

Graduate students who do not enroll for two or more years at TWU must re-enroll under the requirements of the most recent Academic Calendar/program checklist.

### **Definitions:**

Enrolled: students who take one or more semester hours, or who are enrolled in an approved leave of absence.

**Monitoring Data:** Graduation requirements will be carefully monitored through the degree audit process in the Office of the Registrar. The University Registrar will provide Senate with a statement of compliance for the preceding academic year at the last Senate meeting of the academic year.
