Reframing the ageing process



Dr. Faith Richardson has developed and taught courses in gerontology nursing in the BSN and MSN programs. Her doctoral dissertation research involved an Action Research project with the aim of increasing voice in practice with older adults in Assisted Living and Residential Care. Her current research and scholarship continues to focus on promoting positive ageing and well-being throughout the life span through natural and creative therapeutic activities.

What does it mean to age well ... successfully ... positively? In 2012, the World Health Organization (WHO) came out with the campaign, "Adding Life to Years," which promotes healthy ageing and helped to balance the thinking that living long is the end game; we need to be living well in our senior years. Positive ageing takes that one step further to value. How would we be different if we valued our own ageing process, and began to internationalize the value of older adults in our family, our community, and our society? The Hear me roar! project is a movement toward reframing the ageing process as value-added life. Faith introduces this project and the journey of scholarship that led her there.


