From Credence to Competence: Developing an Evidence Base for Compassionate Care



Dr. Sinclair is an Assistant Professor and Cancer Care Research Professor with the University of Calgary, Faculty of Nursing.

His nationally funded program of research focuses on psychosocial and spiritual issues within oncology and palliative care, including his emerging program of research on compassion which has been funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR). Dr. Sinclair is a former CIHR postdoctoral fellow (University of Manitoba) and is a recent recipient of the Canadian Association for Spiritual Care Award of Excellence in Research. Dr. Sinclair's is a certified spiritual care specialist and has practiced in oncology and palliative care for over 13 years. He is the President of the Canadian Association of Psychosocial Oncology, Co-Chair of the Global Network for Spirituality and Health research committee, and a former awardee of Calgary's Top 40 Under 40.

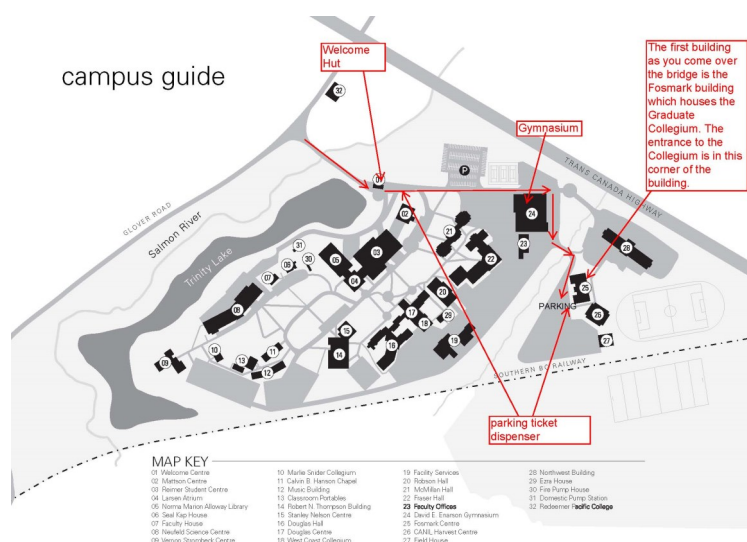
