## Speaker Sarah Gebauer :

Sarah is an Ethicist and the Lead for Clinical Ethics with Fraser Health Ethics Services. Her primary focus is to provide clinical ethics consultation services throughout FHA and to build capacity within the health authority to more critically reflect on the values that ought to guide decisions, during time of ethical uncertainty or distress. She is also directly involved in policy review and support, the development of a research agenda in ethics, ethics infrastructure development, and clinical education.

Sarah has done a numerous workshops and presentations for the FHA and beyond. Recent activities include presentations at the Professional Practice and Integration, Council Orientation, UBC Department of Plastic Surgery Grand Rounds, and the Focus Disabilities Network Society. External commitments include acting in the capacity of a tutor for the UBC Medical School Doctor, Physician, and Society course, sitting on a Provincial Working Group to determine working conditions for ethicists in the province, and consulting with the Community Living B.C. Sarah is also an adjunct instructor at the Boucher Institute of Naturopathic Medicine in New Westminster.

Academically, Sarah has a BA in History and Philosophy from the University of Victoria and an MA in Biomedical and Clinical Ethics from Loma Linda University in Southern California. Her research interests include ethics and resource allocation, ethical decision-making, social justice, and global health.
