## Clinical Education and Teaching Compassion

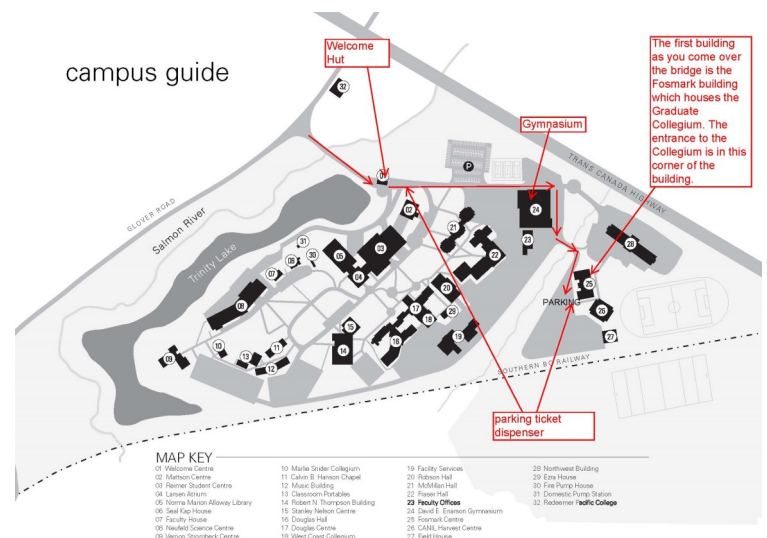
