## Trauma-Informed Practice



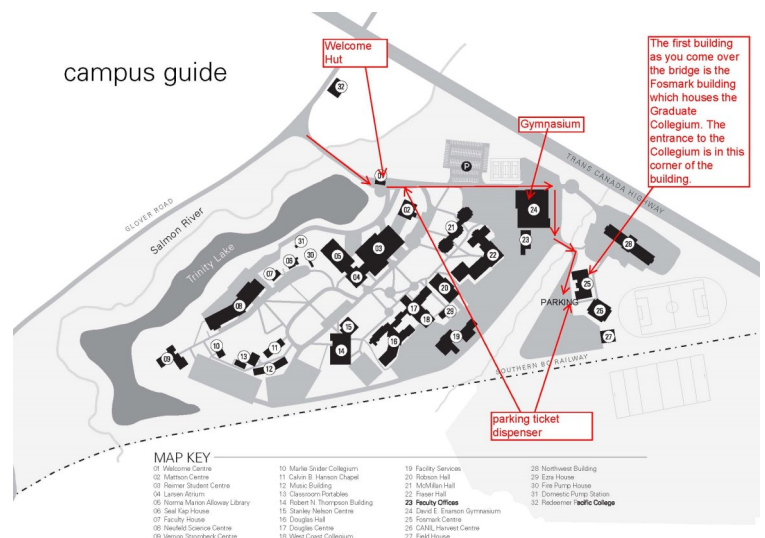
Join us on March 8th 2016 for a dialogue with **Carolyn Higgs** on Trauma-Informed Practice, an approach that is relevant regardless of the setting one works in. Trauma is so prevalent that service providers should naturally assume that many of the people to whom they provide services have, in some way or another, been affected by trauma.

**Carolyn Higgs** is a Registered Psychiatric Nurse currently working as a Nurse Consultant with Surrey Memorial Hospital. Carolyn's experience includes both in-patient and community mental health settings. She has been both a front line worker as well as a leader and supervisor.

Her work is focused on creating a consolidation of existing services to children and youth in one location within the Fraser Valley. Her passion is creating evidenced based interventions that reflect compassionate, trauma informed, patient centered and developmentally appropriate care for those affected by mental illness.
