His research focuses on: person centred care (specific focus on communication between patients, families and carers in palliative and cancer care); suffering; place and quality of death and dying; family caregiving in palliative care.



Cecilia Håkanson, PhD. Dr. Håkanson is Assistant Director and Researcher at Ersta's Palliative Research Centre. Her research focuses on: aspects of embodiment and person centredness related to chronic and/or severe illness and dying; the significance of place in relation to severe illness and dying with focus on aspects of quality and equality.

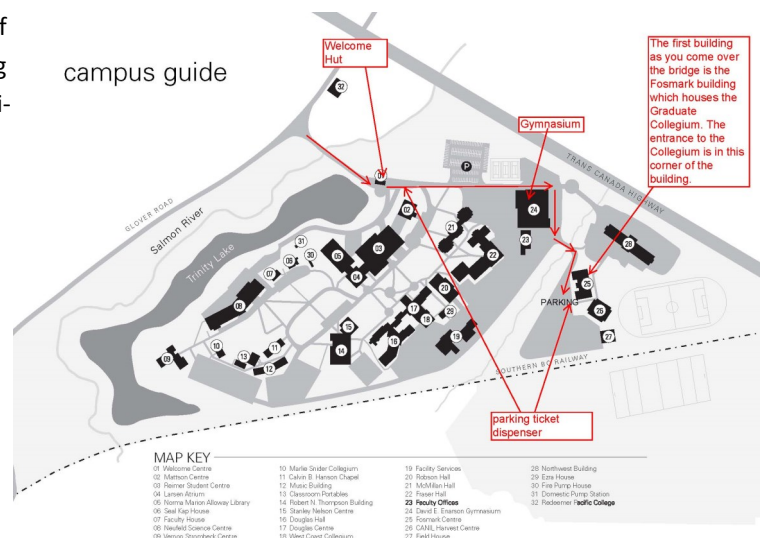
