

## TWU Richmond – Student Leader Job Description

TWU Richmond is growing rapidly and as part of this exciting growth we want to engage with our students more. This year we are offering multiple Student Leader positions to help us with that goal. A limited number of Student Leader Coordinator roles will also be offered to qualified students interested in a more comprehensive experience.

#### **Purpose & Prior Experience**

The Student Leader positions are intentionally designed learning experiences offered to select TWU Richmond students to help you develop your leadership skills while assisting Student Life to enhance our student community. Prior experience is not required, only an openness to try new things and desire to strengthen your servant leadership skills. Any relevant experience and background should be clearly included in your application.

#### What You Can Expect

The Student Leader role will involve new experiences, such as public speaking, leading clubs, promoting events, and meeting other TWU leadership and student leaders. As a student leader you will be expected to attend team meetings as well as some off-site meetings (Langley campus, community events, invited to staff homes, and possibly others). You will be expected to be dependable, self-motivated and passionate about helping build a stronger sense of community at TWU Richmond.

As a Christian university, our Student Leader positions will naturally include times when you will be part of some common Christian traditions like worship, service, teaching & reflection, etc. Although we don't require our Richmond students to be Christians to fulfil this role, you will be expected to support our Student Code of Conduct (<a href="https://www.twu.ca/student-handbook/university-policies/student-code-conduct">https://www.twu.ca/student-handbook/university-policies/student-code-conduct</a>) and participate in these events with an open mind. It is our hope that during your time as a Student Leader you will also benefit from a more hands-on experience and understanding of Christian community.

#### Expectation

An integral part of the Student Leader role will be your attendance and participation in the various meetings and events. All gatherings will be for an intentional and specific purpose designed to enhance your Student Leader experience, and as such considered mandatory (unless otherwise stated). It is important that you acknowledge and agree to this expectation before you assume this role.
