GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Below is a summary of our admission requirements. For more information, visit twu.ca/admissions or call the admissions office at 1.888.GO.TO.TWU.

For B.C. students, the minimum requirement for admission is graduation from high school with a 70% average in English 12 (or equivalent) and three additional Grade 12 courses from TWU's approved course list. Three academic Grade 11 courses are also recommended, including English 11 (*but excluding* physical and health education, career education, applied design, skills and technology, or religious studies courses). We recommend that one course in Grade 11 and one course in Grade 12 be in math or science.

For other provinces, the minimum requirement for admission is graduation from an accredited high school (70% average) with Grade 12 English and the required Grade 12 academic courses. Approved Academic Courses

IB and AP Students

AP and IB courses that are completed along with a high school curriculum may be used in the evaluation process. We will award first-year credit for AP and IB courses with a score of four or higher. Students planning to complete an IB Diploma may be considered for admission based on the predicted grades provided by the IB Coordinator.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Application Fee: None

Early Admission: Apply by March 1, 2021

Regular Admission: Ongoing as space allows

Reporting of Grades: Interim transcripts may be acceptable for early admission. Final official transcripts are required for final approval in August.

Note: We do not use students' self-reported grades online for interim admittance and we are not able to use the electronic PSI system for interim grades.

WHAT'S NEW AT TWU

New School of Business Building

The Robert G. Kuhn building is a state of the art \$35 million four storey building that provides 73,000 square feet of space for the growing School of Business. Set to open for Fall 2021.

School of Education 20th Anniversary

In fall 2001, TWU's School of Education launched the Bachelor of Education degree and full B.C. teaching certification. There are now over 750 teachers across Canada and around the world making an impact in the classroom. The School of Education has experienced significant growth and will be moving to a newly renovated space on campus, doubling the current classroom capacity.

Program Update

The Fall 2021 intake will be the last for the BA in Theatre and BFA in Acting programs. Both programs will close once the final cohort has graduated.

New Career Centre

The new Career Center is focused on supporting students as they realize their calling and strive towards professional development. Several leading-edge initiatives are being implemented, which capture the primary value-adds of a TWU education – high quality mentorship, Student Leadership and Student Employment opportunities.
